The torrents we have on this site is generally seeded by the server. You connect to the server by adding the server as a Peer.

Find out the IP number of the forum web site, using some tool or properties window. Enter the IP number with the port 31740 as a peer. Example: 84.217.53.1:31740

Your computer connects and start to download! If the server don't have a download open, request it by a private message to Tufa moderator.

In the uTorrent software for Windows:

Select the torrent with a problem as the active torrent. click on it. Select the "Peers" tab at the lower half of the view. Right-click to "Add Peer" paste in the IP:Port Hit "OK" It can take several minutes to connect.
